1. Public profession

*1 Corinthians 12:3 - ...no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.*

2. Change of direction

*Acts 26:20 - declaring ...to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, performing deeds appropriate to repentance.*

*Matthew 6:33 - But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness...*

4. Making restitution

*Matthew 5:23-24 - Therefore if you are presenting your offering at the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your offering there before the altar and go; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and present your offering.*
