### # 2- Preparing for Next Sunday God's Story: The Fall Genesis 3

1. Read Genesis 3 with someone.
2. What are some ways that you see disobedience in your life today? (home, work, school, the world)
3. How was disobedience handled in your home while growing up?
4. What is your biggest "need" in your life now? What is one struggle you have bringing it up with others?
5. What is one struggle you have sharing with others? Spend some time in prayer taking these needs of restoration to God.
