- 5. Pray Hebrews 13:20-21 for yourself and for others.

2-Preparing for Next Sunday Being the True Church in our Generation-Part 2 Acts 2:37-47

- 1. READ- Read the passage several times and ask the Lord to reveal Himself and His truth to you. (Acts 2:37-47)
- 2. EXAMINE- Spend some time marking up your Bible. Ask questions like: What is the meaning of the passage, the main thoughts or points?
- 3. APPLY- Apply the text to your own life. Ask these type of questions:
 - ~What does this text tell me about God?
 - ~What does this text tell me about myself?
 - ~How will I live differently because of what I just read?
 - ~Is there a command for me to obey, a warning to observe, a sin I must repent of, or something that leads me to give thanks?
- 4. PRAY- Pray through the passage and your application. Ask God to lead you to love Him, love others and to be intentional about making disciples by the power of the Holy Spirit.
